

NEW POOL UPDATE

After nearly sixty years of continuous service, the Zelianople Community swimming pool is fast approaching the end of its useful life span. The pool has been a gathering place and beloved part of our community that has brought countless hours of enjoyment to three generations. Now the time has come for us to embrace those past decades of memories but begin to look to the future so that our children and grandchildren can continue to build their own wonderful memories at the Zelig Pool!

On behalf of the Zelianople borough, the Park Board has undertaken a campaign to raise funds to replace the current pool as well as to upgrade the bathhouse and surrounding green space area. The proposed design is a state of the art modern facility which will offer heated water, zero depth access, fountain features, diving boards, slides and lane swimming for fitness training and competitive meets. There will be something for all ages!

As a first step in this process, we have applied for Department of Conservation and Natural Resource (DCNR) grant funding. The Borough has committed to match any funds that are ultimately awarded by the DCNR. However, there is no doubt that in order for the project to be successful, we will need to raise significant funds through the private sector.

Zelianople is widely known for its community spirit and wonderful small town atmosphere. This is a place where everyone pulls together and supports their friends and neighbors. It is important for us to support the kind of infrastructure that has made this town so special through the years. There will be any number of ways that you can help to make this project successful and we are counting on everyone's help and support. Shelter reservations are not guaranteed until receipt of contract and payment. Shelters will be clean and ready for use after 9:00AM on the day of rental.

After use, trash should be picked up and shelter area left in a reasonable manner. Place trash bags in dumpster. Bags are not supplied by the park.

Shelter area closes at 11:00PM. Clean up and vacate by midnight.

Alcohol is permitted only in hilltop shelters (Shelters #1 through #4). A separate \$10.00 check is required.

Tables cannot be removed from shelters.

Shelters are wired for electricity and there are grills in shelters #1 thru #4.

Incident Weather /Pool Closings /Delays

The pool may close or fail to open if the outdoor temperature is at 70 degrees or below.* The pool may close due to low attendance or other safety factors. If the weather improves, the pool will reopen at 1:00 or 3:00PM*. If the pool does not reopen by 5:00PM, it will remain closed for the day.

*Subject to change

If a patron purchases a pool admission, and the pool closes within 30 minutes, rain checks will be issued. The pool has no refund policy.

Children ages 10 and under, must be accompanied by a person 16 or older at all times, at pool manager's discretion.

Just a reminder that inflatable water wings are not permitted on infants/children/young swimmers. Only Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted..

SWIM LESSON LEVELS

YOUNG BEGINNER: Ages 3 and up

Fully submerging the face, bubble blowing, supported float, locomotion in chest deep water, and kicking on front and back.

BEGINNER I: Front and back glides without support, floating on front and back without support, basics of swimming strokes, turning over front to back and back to front.

BEGINNER II: Freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, and standing diving

ADVANCED BEGINNER: Swimming length of pool, breaststroke and standing diving.

INTERMEDIATE: Swimming 50 yards freestyle and backstroke, learning the dolphin stroke, treading in deep for five minutes, basic life saving.

PROFICIENT: Training with more advanced lifesaving and swimming longer distances.






ZELIENOPE WORKOUT PARK is being designed to help establish a stronger, healthier community.
