

**ORDINANCE NO: 846-16
ZELIENOPLE BOROUGH
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF ZELIENOPLE BOROUGH AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 260, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE V, ON-STREET METERED PARKING AND ARTICLE VI, OFF-STREET METERED PARKING, TO ELIMINATE SOME ON-STREET AND OFF-STREET METERED PARKING AND ESTABLISH NEW PARKING REGULATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Zelienople, the Borough Council of the Borough of Zelienople, Butler County, Pennsylvania, has determined it necessary to amend the Code of Ordinances to eliminate metered parking on certain streets and in certain parking lots within the Borough and to establish new parking regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ZELIENOPLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AND WITH THE SAME THAT:

SECTION 1:

The Title and Whereas clauses stated above are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance by reference.

SECTION 2:

The Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Zelienople at Chapter 20, Vehicles and Traffic, Article V, On-Street Metered Parking is hereby amended as follows:

- a. 2 Hour Parking
 - i. All on-street metered parking is hereby abolished and replaced with 2 hour parking on the following streets:
 - a. Main Street
 - b. East New Castle Street
 - c. West New Castle Street
 - d. East Spring Street
 - e. West Spring Street

- ii. Exceptions:
 - a. There shall be 2 parking spaces on the west side of Main Street at the Post Office which shall have the parking limited to 15 minutes for Post Office customers only.
 - b. Parking spaces on Spring Street east of the Harper Building (Parcel #550-S2-BL10) shall be unrestricted.
 - c. Parking spaces on West Spring Street, west of the Spring Street parking lot exit, shall be unrestricted.
 - d. The two parking spaces on the south side of West New Castle Street near the intersection with Main Street (adjacent to the former Kaufman House Restaurant – Parcel #550-S2-BH24) are hereby abolished. That area is to be a no parking zone.

- iii. Enforcement:
 - a. The 2 hour parking restrictions shall be enforced Monday through Saturday 8am to 5pm. No parking is permitted from the hours of 3am to 5am with the exception of a special permit issued by the Chief of Police.
 - b. The 2 hour parking restriction is cumulative for all parking spaces in areas where the restriction applies and is not applied on a per space basis.

- iv. Fines:
 - a. The fine imposed for violation of the 2 hour parking limit shall be \$25.00
 - b. Second Violation of the 2 hour parking limit per Calendar Year shall be required to pay the fine plus a \$25.00 penalty = \$50.00
 - c. Third Violation of the 2 hour parking limit per Calendar Year shall be required to pay the fine plus a \$50.00 penalty = \$75.00
 - d. Fourth Violation and all subsequent violations of the 2 hour parking limit per Calendar Year shall be required to pay the fine plus a \$75.00 penalty = \$100.00
 - e. In the event that it is determined by the Borough that a ticket issued for a 2 hour parking violation is a second or subsequent violation of the current calendar year, the Chief of Police shall notify the violator in writing that an additional fine is required in accordance with the fine schedule. If the violator, after receiving the ticket or written notice of violation does not pay the fine, the Chief of Police shall have the violator cited under the Borough Ordinances with an additional fine of not more than \$300.00 plus costs.

SECTION 3:

The Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Zelienople at Chapter 20, Vehicles and Traffic, Article VI, Off-Street Metered Parking is hereby amended as follows:

- a. All off street metered parking in the Grandview and Spring Street municipal parking lots are hereby abolished.
- b. Pay by Space Parking
 - i. Pay by Space parking using multi space kiosks is hereby established in the Spring Street, Grandview and Town Center municipal parking lots.
 - ii. Space numbers shall be displayed on posts and/or painted on the actual parking space.
 - iii. Parking fee shall be \$.25 per 30 minutes.
 - iv. Enforcement shall be Monday through Saturday 8am to 5pm, excluding Borough holidays.
 - v. No parking shall be permitted in the lots from 3am to 5am unless a Parking Permit is issued and displayed in accordance with section C below.
- c. Permit Parking
 - i. The Chief of Police may issue Parking Permits in accordance with rules and regulations established by Borough Council.
 - ii. Vehicles displaying the parking permit while parked in any of the 3 named municipal lots are not subject to the fee and parking restrictions laid out in this Ordinance.
- d. Parking Passes
 - i. The Chief of Police may issue monthly Parking Passes.
 - ii. The fee for Parking Passes shall be \$25.00 per month.
 - iii. Vehicles displaying the Parking Pass shall be permitted to park in any of the 3 named municipal lots without paying the \$.25 per 30 minute fee.
- e. Clay Street and High Street

The 2 hour parking restriction on Clay and High Streets are hereby abolished.

SECTION 4:

The Chief of Police may restrict or add parking regulations for any roadway in the Borough on a temporary basis to provide for the safety and security of persons within the Borough. Events that may require temporary parking regulations “but not limited to” are: parades, festivals, community events, and construction projects (both commercial and residential).

SECTION 5:

Borough may amend the fees established by this Ordinance from time to time by Resolution of Borough Council.

SECTION 6:

Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
