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SWIM LESSON LEVELS

Swim lessons (registration forms available online at www.myzeliepark.org)

YOUNG BEGINNER: Ages 3 and up

Fully submerging the face, bubble blowing, supported float, locomotion in chest deep water, and kicking on front and back.

BEGINNER I: Front and back glides without support, floating on front and back without support, basics of swimming strokes, turning over front to back and back to front.

BEGINNER II: Freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, and standing diving

ADVANCED BEGINNER: Swimming length of pool, breaststroke and standing diving.

INTERMEDIATE: Swimming 50 yards freestyle and backstroke, learning the dolphin stroke, treading in deep for five minutes, basic life saving.

PROFICIENT: Training with more advanced lifesaving and swimming longer distances.

After use, trash should be picked up and shelter area left in a reasonable manner. Place trash bags in dumpster. Bags are not supplied by the park.

Shelter area closes at 11:00PM. Clean up and vacate by midnight.

Alcohol is permitted only in hilltop shelters (Shelters #1 thru #4). A separate \$10.00 check is required.

Tables cannot be removed from shelters.

Shelters are wired for electricity and there are grills in shelters #1 thru #4. It is recommended that you check your shelter prior to use to determine if you will need to furnish a grill.

SHELTER RENTALS Cont'd

Additional swimming passes are available at half price with shelter rental.

The ball field is associated with shelter #2. Other shelters can use the ball field if not in use and with permission of shelter #2. (Shelter #2 has first right of use of the ball field) Please let us know if you will need the ball field. Scheduled games have priority.

Parking is available at the top of the hill near shelters 1 thru 4.

When you call to reserve a shelter, a contract will be sent. If a problem arises with the rental of the shelter, call the park at 724-452-0231 or check with the park maintenance person.

All cancellations must be made within 30 days of receipt of application. No Refunds.

The pool may close or fail to open if the outdoor temperature is at 70 degrees or below.* The pool may close due to low attendance or other safety factors. If the weather improves, the pool will reopen at 1:00 or 3:00PM*. If the pool does not reopen by 5:00PM, it will remain closed for the day.

If a patron purchases a pool admission, and the pool closes within 30 minutes, rain checks will be issued. The pool has no refund policy.

Children ages 10 and under, must be accompanied by a person 16 or older at all times, at pool manager's discretion.
