

# *Minutes of the Borough Council Zelienople, PA*

The August 10, 2009 Public Hearing of the Zelienople Borough Council was called to order at 7:30 PM in the council chambers by President Charles Underwood, as advertised. The purpose of the hearing was to take public comment on proposed Ordinance #794-09, an ordinance of the Borough of Zelienople, Butler County, amending Ordinance Number 578 of 1979, as subsequently amended through September of 2007, and entitled "Zoning," including the comprehensive rezoning of the Zoning Map to include an Airport Hazard Zoning Overlay in accordance with the authority conferred by the act of October 10, 1984, P.L. 837, NO. 164, codified at 74 PA.C.S.A. § 5101 with related standards; to add definitions and corresponding standards for amateur radio antenna structures apart from that applied to antennas in general; removing Service Stations as an authorized use in the C-1 Central Business District; miscellaneous amendments to those provisions of Part 9, Signs relating to promotional signs for nonprofit events and real estate sales signs; and further miscellaneous amendments.

In attendance were Council members Russell Robertson, James Zeigler, Marietta Reeb, George McDowell, and Allen Bayer. Mayor Thomas Oliverio Council member Andrew Mathew III, and Junior Council member Spencer Mathew were not present.

Manager Donald Pepe, Assistant Manager Jill Stedina, Solicitor Matt Racunas, Engineer Tom Thompson and Police Chief Jim Miller were also present.
